

**PHOTOGRAPHY, THREE & TWO DIMENSIONAL CATEGORIES
SUBMISSION OF WORKS TO BE JUDGED & CONSIDERED FOR SCHOLARSHIP**

Due Friday, January 29, 2010

*All images submitted for scholarship will also be submitted to the Nerman Museum of Contemporary for exhibit consideration. All original art work of images submitted **must be available for exhibit through April 25, 2010.** Finalists or their parent(s) will sign a Loan Agreement Form from the Nerman Museum of Contemporary Art for the duration of the student exhibit. **ONLY one (1)** image and its corresponding original artwork will be selected by the Nerman Museum of Contemporary Art in late January 2010 for the exhibit.*

Definition of Visual Arts Categories

Two-Dimensional (art work created by the student, including computer generated works, in the following categories: painting, drawing, graphic design, mixed media, printmaking)

Three-dimensional (Ceramic, glass, sculpture, jewelry, metal- smithing, and textile and fiber design)

Photography (original photo must be created by the student. Original student photos that have been manipulated through technology should be submitted in this category)

VISUAL ARTS GUIDELINES

Friday, January 29, 2010 - DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF ART WORKS ON CD DISK.

1. **Finalists (nominated students) must complete & submit a Judging Form and Resume by December 4, 2009**
 - **Judges Form**
 - **Upload your resume**
1. Each Finalist must submit **ART WORK ENTRIES ON A SINGLE CD DISK as .jpg files, 90-120 dpi**
2. **ART WORKS MUST REPRESENT SEVEN DIFFERENT PIECES.**
3. The art work represented in the submitted CD Disk must have been created by the student nominee within the past two years and be the student's own composition.
4. Candidates in three-dimensional art may submit up to three shots/photos per art work.
5. The art work submitted should demonstrate originality, creativity and versatility of medium.
6. **WE WILL NOT ACCEPT LATE ENTRIES.**

SUBMISSION OF IMAGES:

CD DISK ENTRIES (as .jpg files) for Two-Dimensional, Three Dimensional & Photography:

1. Artworks submitted for the Two and Three-Dimensional, Photography must be submitted on a CD disk (as .jpg files). 90-120 dpi.
2. Each student nominee must submit their works on a separate CD disk.
3. Images must be jpg files and dpi range of 90-120.
4. Image file name **MUST include**:
 - *last name of finalist with first letter of first name plus the image number. For example, vanlanduyts1.jpg, vanlanduyts2.jpg, vanlanduyts3.jpg, etc.*
5. Each finalist **MUST** submit a **TOTAL OF SEVEN IMAGES**
Five of the seven images **MUST** meet the following specifications:
 - Two-dimensional & photograph maximum image size will not exceed 24" x 18" x 1" deep.
 - Three-dimensional maximum size: 15" high x 10" wide x 10" deep.
 - Three-Dimensional candidates may submit up to three photo shots per entry.
6. **SUBMIT WITH THE IMAGES:** a **PRINTED** word document with the following information for all **SEVEN (7)** artworks:
PLEASE first list the five pieces of art works being submitted for Nerman Exhibit.
 - Image file name, e.g., heilc1.jpg followed by:
 - Full Name of Finalist
 - High School
 - Nominating Teacher
 - MEDIUM
 - Size of original work... **BE VERY SPECIFIC on height, width and depth.**
7. The submitted artworks must have been created by the student nominee within the past two years.
8. The **WORD DOCUMENT LISTING ARTWORDS** must accompany the CD Disk (images as .jpg files).

VISUAL ARTS CATEGORIES JUDGING CRITERIA.

- Art works presented in the two-dimensional art, three-dimensional art and photography categories must demonstrate originality, creativity and versatility of medium.
- Consideration will be given to the student's involvement in extracurricular and community activities or volunteerism, especially if it relates to his/her artistic talent and capability.
- Consideration may be given to student honors and awards.
- Decision of the Judge is Final.
